

HOW TO MAKE A MASON JAR AQUARIUM



SUPPLIES NEEDED TO MAKE A MASON JAR AQUARIUM

- mason jars
- blue food coloring
- filtered water
- aquarium plastic figurines or toy fish
- blue and white glitter (optional)
- glycerin (optional, helps water flower more slowly)
- aquarium rocks and plastic plants

HOW TO MAKE A MASON JAR AQUARIUM

- 1. Add rocks and plants to your mason jar.
- 2. Fill with water and add some plastic sea creatures.
- 3. Add some blue food coloring until you are satisfied with the color.
- 4. Add glitter if available.
- 5. Add a few drops of glycerin more if you want the water to flow mores slowly and look more viscous.
- 6. Screw lid shut (you can also glue the lid with some hot glue if you'd like).
- 7. Gently swirl to see your sea creatures swim!
