

HOW TO MAKE A PIN THE TAIL ON THE OCTOPUS GAME



SUPPLIES NEEDED TO MAKE A PIN THE TAIL ON THE OCTOPUS GAME

- poster board or large sheet of craft paper
- one sheet of card stock or thicker paper
- favorite colored craft paint
- markers
- tape
- scissors
- bandana or some other blind fold
- prizes for winners

HOW TO MAKE A PIN THE TAIL ON THE OCTOPUS GAME

1. Start by laying the poster board or craft paper on a table and paint your octopus shape (only paint 7 tentacles). You can paint other animals if you'd like, but make sure you leave an animal part off, so it can be placed during the game.
2. Write the game name around the painting (example above)
3. With a sheet of card stock or thicker paper, cut out the shape of a tentacle and paint to match the octopus.
4. Apply a small piece of tape to the back of the tentacle, so it can be applied to the game board.

HOW TO PLAY

1. Hang the game board on a tree or wall and place the unattached tentacle on a table about 7 feet away from the board.
2. With the bandana, blindfold the first contestant and hand them the unattached tentacle.
3. Aim the contestant towards the board and let them place the tentacle as best they can.
4. Repeat with each contestant and whoever can pin it correctly wins a prize!
